# E. Next Steps

Myra Jones-Taylor thanked everyone for their hard work and voiced her enthusiasm and excitement about the Office of Early Childhood (OEC). The OEC will be located in the State Office Building on the ground floor. Connecticut Charts-a-Course will be moving to the State Office Building on Monday, July 1. Mara Siladi and Carlota Schechter will be staying on for one year as the implementation team. Linda Goodman will be on loan to the OEC from DDS for one year. Harriet Feldlaufer, Lynn Johnson, Deb Johnson and Karen Foley-Schain make up the leadership / management team of the OEC. A feasibility study will be conducted to assess Birth to 3 moving to the OEC. Myra has also been reaching out to the EC Funder's Collaborative to support the work of the new office.

The Early Childhood Cabinet will remain as currently stated in legislation. The Governor's office is working within the parameters of the current legislation to add the Executive Director of the OEC to the Cabinet membership. Karen Ponder from BUILD will be consulting with the Cabinet to assist with the transition. Karen expressed her pleasure on working with Connecticut during the transition.

David Title announced his resignation from the Cabinet effective June 30. He acknowledged the hard work of the leadership team and the importance of moving the work of the Cabinet to the OEC. John Rathgeber, former chair of the Cabinet, stated his appreciation of the work of the Cabinet and reminded us of the moral and economic imperative to have every child in the state have a high-quality education. He acknowledged David Title's passion, leadership skills and hard work in moving this work forward. The recommendations of the Cabinet to the OEC will make a difference in children's lives. Mr. Rathgeber presented David Title with a proclamation from Governor Malloy acknowledging him for his service. He also wished Dr. Jones-Taylor well.
